DAAR provides electrical and fire inspection, and fire protection and training support to the US Army Corps of Engineers, Gulf Region Division through its collaboration with Stanley Baker Hill, LLC. The task force is a partnership among the Multi-National Force-Iraq (MNF-I), the Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA) and USACE and provides the services of 70 master electricians and 30 fire protection specialists in this considerable safety and inspection effort. This \$59.5 million dollar contract calls for the inspection of 85,000 military facilities, 4,500 buildings and 250 contingency operation locations located throughout Iraq within a one year time frame. The task force works hand in hand with the 249<sup>th</sup> Engineer Battalion, the DCMA and additional government personnel to inspect facilities used by U.S. troops and civilians in Iraq to ensure facilities meet code and minimize the risks of injury, death and fires.
